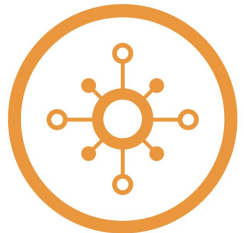

Looking Back

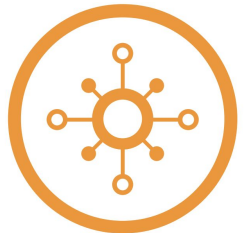
Spring 2017 - Regional Opportunity Initiatives, Inc. (ROI) awards Dubois County a 10 month Ready Schools Development Grant.

Fall 2017 - Dubois County Ready Schools design teams begin moving through the 5 stages of the Design Thinking process.

Spring 2018 - Dubois County Ready Schools design teams develop and submit an implementation plan and proposal.

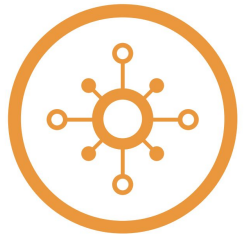
Summer 2018 - Regional Opportunity Initiatives, Inc. (ROI) awards Dubois County a 3 - 4 year Ready Schools Implementation Grant.

Fall 2018 - Hub 19 becomes a reality and with the support of an advisory council and a task force, begins implementing the strategies of the grant.



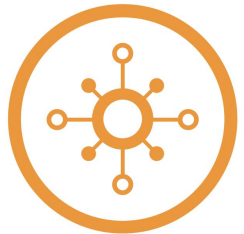
The 6 Ready Schools Core Principles that guided our efforts:

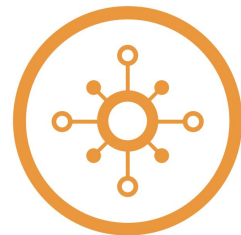

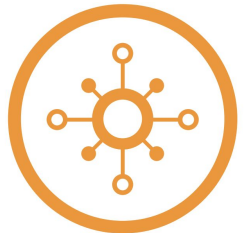

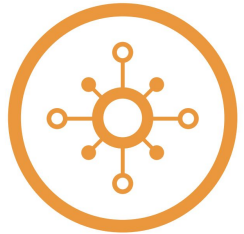
Engaged and Relevant Learning Environments

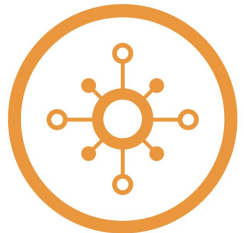
Current Strategy Actions
