

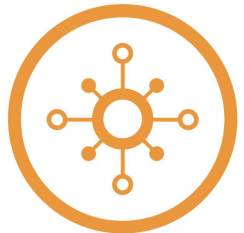

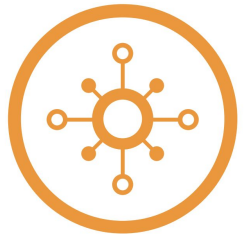

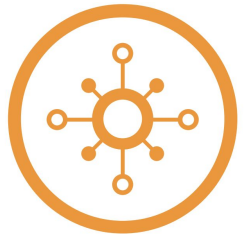


What can Hub19 do to support teachers?

Other training support so far: Naviance Career Software, The Leader in Me program, PLTW, and Summit Learning

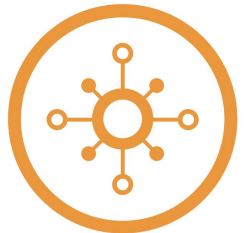


What can Hub19 do to support teachers?

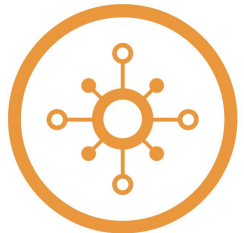
